
- √ 309 Intake Interviews Conducted

 - 39 Owner changed mind or found home

Foster Report


- ✓ 217 Foster Homes

Dogs Rescued, by Age







2009 Microchip Summary

- ✓ 247 Goldens were accepted by GRREAT in 2009.
- 22 Goldens passed away or were euthanized and 18 were transferred to other rescues, leaving 207 Goldens to chip.
- √ 180 of the 2009 dogs were chipped by GRREAT; 8 later died or were transferred.
- √ 32 dogs had existing chips; three of these were re-chipped.
- ✓ This represents 99% of the available dogs!
- 2 dogs from 2009 are still un-chipped.
- ✓ 2 dogs were identified/recovered by microchip in 2009.

2009 Microchip Summary



99% of 2009 dogs are chipped!

Microchipping Issue for 2010

✓ AVID Registry Problems

- AVID's registration problems have gotten worse. They often are not adding individual dog information to their registry. Jessie discussed this with me and we've decided to register each dog chipped using the prepaid forms provided by AVID. A change to a different chip provider, such as HomeAgain, should be considered.
