






Where Dogs Come From











Microchipping Report

2010 Microchip Summary

- ✓ 233 Goldens were accepted by GRREAT in 2010.
- 7 Goldens passed away or were euthanized and 5 were transferred to other rescues, leaving 221 Goldens to chip.
- √ 173 of the 2010 dogs were chipped by GRREAT; 7 later died or were transferred.
- 44 dogs had existing chips; 15 of these were rechipped.
- ✓ This represents 91.8% of the available dogs.
- ✓ 19 dogs from 2010 are still un-chipped.
- ✓ 4 dogs were identified/recovered by microchip in 2010: one twice!

Microchipping Issue for 2011

✓ AVID Registry Problems

- AVID's registration problems have not improved this past year. I've been registering the chips with AVID using the prepaid forms. At first, AVID responded to my e-mails but that soon stopped. A change to a different chip provider is an option. AKC chips are cheaper; however, they include one label with the chip number instead of four. Another consideration is that all chip numbers can be registered with the AKC.
